VAY-SM Badminton Rules and Rally Scoring System

All players must be inside the gym within proximity of the courts for the entire preliminary round matches. A match in the preliminary round consists of two (2) games up to fifteen (15) points with no setting. Win by two (2) points do not apply.* You may request line judges and/or service judge at any time during the preliminary round.* A match in the playoff round consists of the best of three (3) games to fifteen (15) points with setting at thirteen (13) points to five (5) and fourteen (14) points to three (3). Win by two (2) points do not apply.** Line judges will be required and service judge will officiate matches during playoff round (Semi and Final).** Side that reaches eight (8) points first in the third (3rd) game in the playoff round has the option of switching side. ** Feather shuttles (birds) will be issued. Each match will receive one (1) game bird and two (2) warm-up birds. Additional birds are issued upon request. Match winner will bring clipboard, pencil and birds back to the tournament desk. Serves that touch the net and lands inside the service box are fair. Side serving must say the score out loud before each serve. Side winning a rally adds a point to its score. Side winning a game serves first in the next game. A two (2) minute interval between each game is allowed. There is only one server in doubles and mixed-doubles. The service passes consecutively to the players as shown in the diagram. At the beginning of the game and when the score is even, the server serves from the right court. When it is odd, the server serves from the left court. If the serving side wins a rally, the serving side scores a point and the same server serves again from the alternate service court. If the receiving side wins a rally, the receiving side scores a point. The receiving side becomes the new serving side. The player of the receiving side who served last stays in the same service court from where he/she served last. The reverse pattern applies to the receivers partner. The players do not change their respective service courts until they win a point when their side is serving. Each win of a match earns the team one point. These points are used to determine which four (4) teams will advance to the playoffs. In an event of a tie, scores earned will determine the outcome. Advantage goes to team with higher scores per game. Top four (4) teams will play in the playoffs. Discrepancies must be addressed immediately before the next rally and not after a match. See Coordinator. Coordinator reserve the right to modify rules and regulations at any time without prior notice.
